## What is Cybercrime?

Cybercrime is broadly defined as "the use of networked computers or Internet technology to commit or facilitate the commission of a crime". However, like traditional crimes, cyber-crime incorporates a huge range of illicit behaviours.

**#Digital Footprint Crimes** that involve the use of the Internet to facilitate drug dealing, people smuggling and many other 'traditional' crimes.

**#Internet Facilitated Crime** Crimes that involve the use of the Internet to facilitate drug dealing, people smuggling and many other 'traditional' crimes.

**#Cyber-Enabled Crime** Crimes that may be committed without IT devices, but are changed significantly by the use of it in terms of scale and reach.

**#Cyber-Dependent Crime** Crimes that can only be committed through the use of IT devices, where the devices are both the tool for committing the crime and the target of the crime. Home Office cyber-crime definitions - Tech UK (2015)
